At this **WIN 20th Anniversary Annual General Meeting** record number of attendees 115 persons gathered to conduct the AGM and celebration of the 20th Anniversary at the AVANI+ Riverside Hotel in Bangkok.

115 participants including some of our member's spouses and we were also very happy to welcome **Sir Eligio Oggionni and Mr. Daniel Stein**, two former Chairmen of WIN. Unfortunately, **Mr. S.K. Leong** could not attend but sent his best wishes for this WIN Anniversary and achievements.

Not only we conducted the AGM process as it is required by Law to be done for Associations, but also we conducted a first session on behalf of **WIN Logistics AG as "shareholders"** to decide on the projects and tools to be developed for the benefit of the WIN members.

It was in fact the third time WIN conducted its AGM in Thailand however it was the first time we gathered in Bangkok. Furthermore, this time the AGM was entirely organized by WIN office following the new rules that no host should be bothered with organizational tasks of an AGM. The venue and the concept were perfect and proved to be right for WIN.

Apart from the official conference, discussions and the elections, 20 Bilateral meeting sessions were offered to members. And obviously the Gala Evening, the **20 Year Celebration of WIN** presented the highlight of this 2020 AGM.

These were the main topics discussed at the AGM 2020:

In line with the founding of WIN Logistics AG, a WIN company that is supposed to offer tools and services to WIN members and, to eventually be financially self-supporting, following projects were presented by the respective Board member who will take the lead in developing the project:

• Online Rate Management & Booking – presented by Jacques Abouzeid

Overall scope: Digitalization of Freight Forwarding. Lower respond time for quotation, avoid double work and research, lower time used for quotation, lower cost of sales.

Investment in rate management tools, Track & trace features, online 24/7, complete one-stopshop logistics platform with EDI integrator, online booking & status update, digital freight forwarders, online freight marketplaces.

• Procurement Project - presented by Juri Falandt

Overall scope: lower cost and / or increase income by consolidating buying power of WIN members

This project consists of several side projects such as: Airfreight incentive programs, FCL / LCL VID or incentive programs, better deals from Hotels and for Tickets for travel for WIN members, IT - platform (as described before) WIN Insurance, Bill of lading etc.

• Bill of Lading Project - presented by Matthew Cheung

Key elements cover by WIN Bill of lading: WIN Bill of Lading's Company Formation under WIN Logistics AG whom being the Holding Business Entity, to be a Legal Company issuing WIN Bill of Lading.

Automatization & IT support: system B/L Nos. generation + IT maintenance fee along with technical support in case system malfunction

Maritime Liability Insurance: market benchmark being 0.95-1.2% of Billing Lading Issuance party's annual turnover \$\$

FMC Bonded - N. America: Annual base rate as USD4,000 + USD5.00 per rate filing subject to principle entity's financial background support

• WIN Handling Fee - presented by Ron Sham

Overall scope of this project: Recognition for members that are contributing to the network with nomination cargo and to generate some income for WIN Company. Key benefits: motivation for members to contribute business to WIN members, accurate numbers of business traded within WIN by more cautious EP completion, more transparent EP results, MIS tool for the WIN Board to identify weak areas





• Vertical Markets Project - presented by Jon Iglesias and Peter van der Klift

To create a platform for the WIN members to follow the intended exhibitions, based on vertical markets. Key benefits: interested Members can save cost on exhibitions for marketing purposes and stall renting if sharing participation, increase WIN awareness, identify vertical niches and market participation if members join forces, target Global Accounts per Vertical Market & Industry specialization.

• Further topics:

The WIN membership fees will remain unchanged once again also for the year 2020. The proposed Budget 2020 for WIN Association and for WIN Logistics AG were approved.

• Special Award for attending 20 WIN AGM's

During the past 20 years WIN conducted an AGM every Year in January. Until only 4 years ago, WIN AGM venues were alternating by WIN Regions: Americas, Europe, APAC (there was no MEA Region at that time). Although, the AGM took place at exotic and most wonderful places that one can imagine, the travel time and cost was often a stumbling block for many members to attend.
